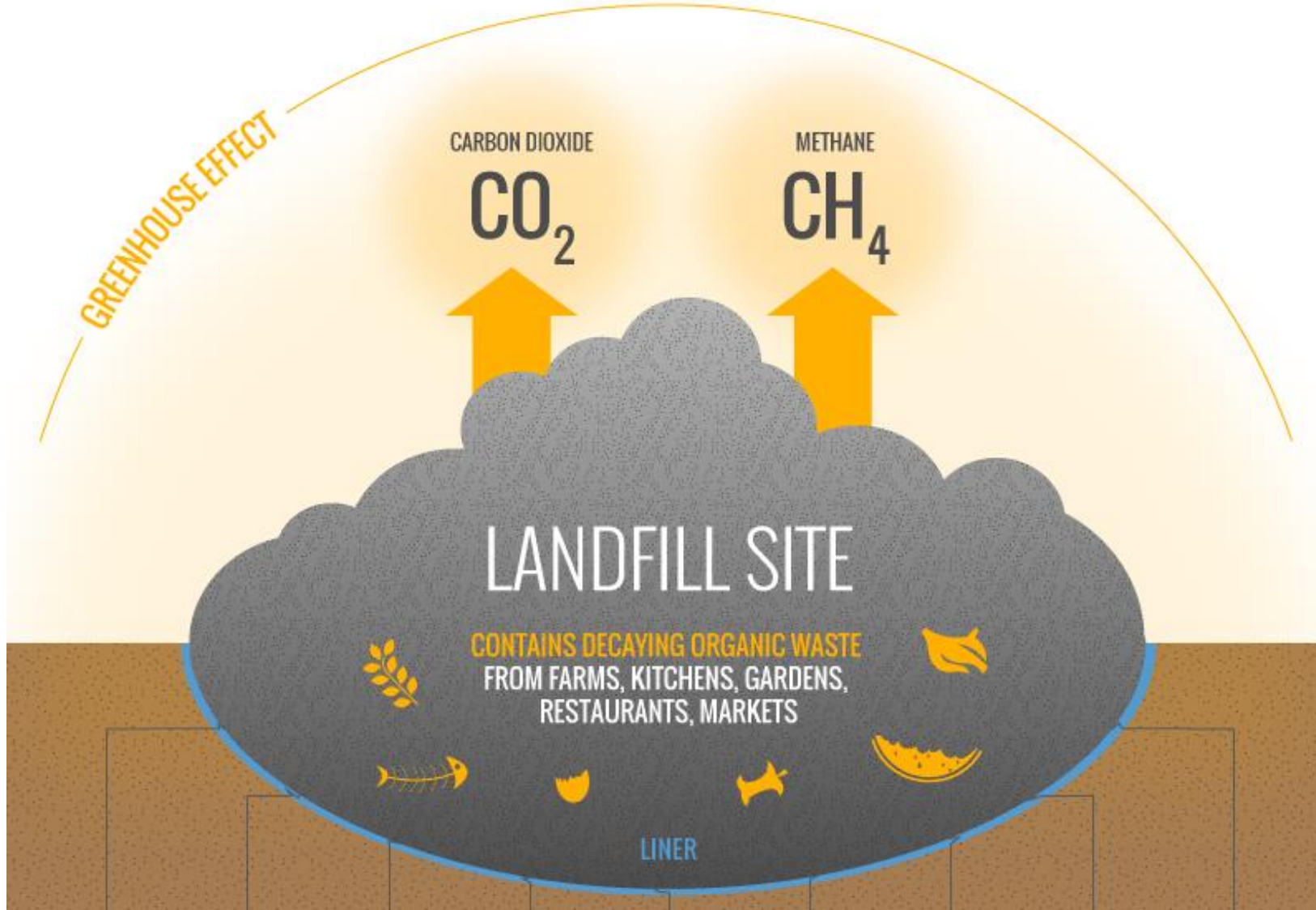

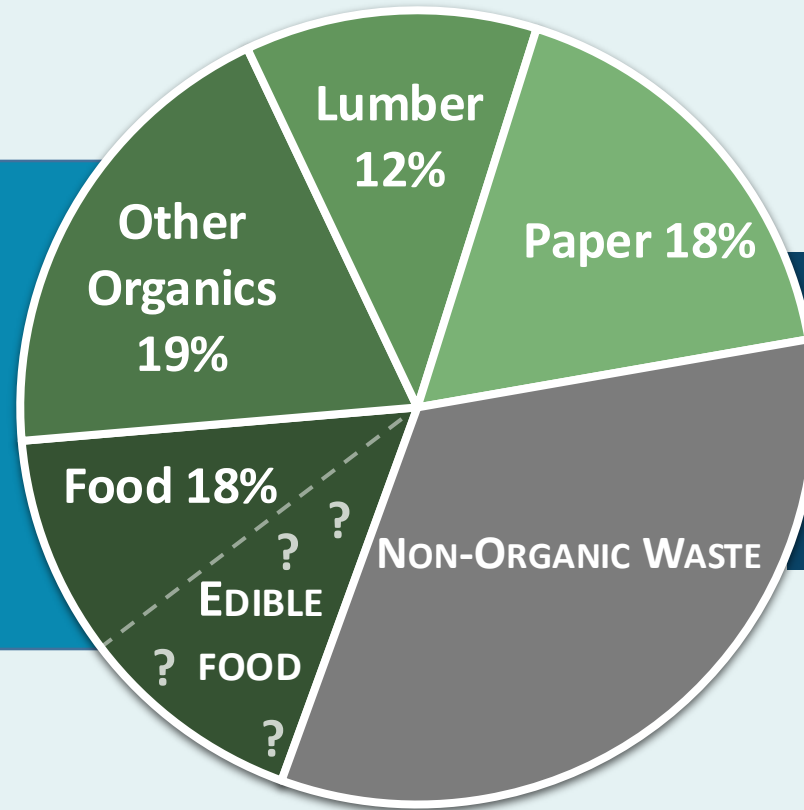

2020

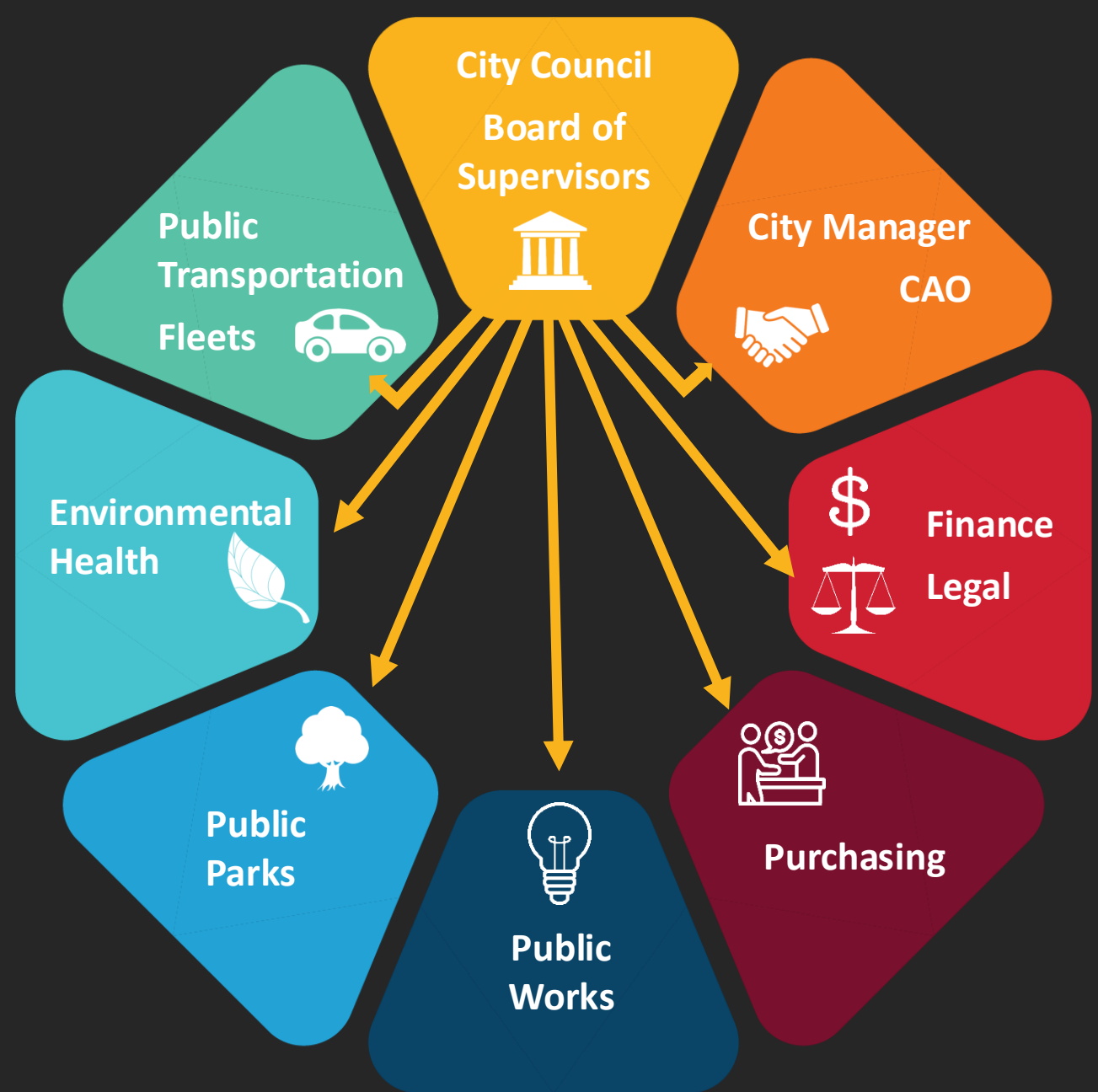

JURISDICTION ENFORCEMENT REQUIREMENTS



Must Have Enforcement and Inspection Program that Includes:

- **Annual Compliance Review**
 - Commercial Businesses that Generate > 2 Cubic Yards/week
 - Verify Businesses are:
 - Subscribed to Service or Self-hauling
- **Route Reviews:**

Residential Areas to verify service and Inspect for Contamination
