A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE OCEANO  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT TO DECLARE A WATER SHORTAGE FOR  
THE COMMUNITY OF OCEANO

WHEREAS, in California, water is a precious and limited resource that must be used wisely; and

WHEREAS, calendar year 2013 was the driest year on record and 2014 is projected to be critically dry as well; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2014 Governor Brown proclaimed a drought state of emergency, calling on local urban water suppliers and municipalities to implement their local water shortage contingency plans immediately and calling on all Californians to reduce their water usage by 20 percent; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2014, the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 2014-64, a proclamation of local emergency due to the severe drought conditions; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2014, a Public Hearing was held and public comment was heard and considered in regards to the current drought conditions and the Board's declaration of a severe water shortage for the community of Oceano.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Oceano Community Services District hereby finds, determines, and declares a water shortage for the community of Oceano.


