A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE OCEANO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 9-15. 2022 AS FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

WHEREAS, the Oceano Community Services District is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in the visiting Oceano; and

WHEREAS, fire is a serious concern both locally and nationally, and homes are the locations where people are at greatest risk from fire; and

WHEREAS, home fires caused 2,580 civilian deaths in the United States in 2020, according to the National Fire Protection Association ® (NFPA®), and fire departments in the United States responded to 356,500 home fires; and

WHEREAS, smoke alarms sense smoke well before you can, alerting you to danger in the event of fire in which you may have as little as two minutes to escape to safely; and

WHEREAS, working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in reported home fires in half; and

WHEREAS, Oceano, CA residents should be sure everyone in the home understands the sounds of the smoke alarms and knows how to respond; and

WHEREAS, Oceano, CA residents who have planned and practiced a home fire escape plan are more prepared and will therefore be more likely to survive a fire; and

WHEREAS, Oceano, CA residents will make sure their smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarms meet the needs of all their family members, including those with sensory or physical disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Oceano, CA first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

WHEREAS, Oceano, CA residents that are responsive to public education measures are better able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire, especially in their homes; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Fire Prevention Week TM theme, "Fire won't wait. Plan your escape.\textstyle{TM}," effectively serves to remind Oceano, CA, it is important to have a home fire escape plan.

Recommendation

It is recommended that your Board consider the appeal by Myron and Helena Leal on a water bill and provide staff direction as deemed appropriate.

Discussion

The Leal's are the owners of 1130 Tranquill Ct. For the 5/18/2022 - 7/18/2022 billing period, 73 units of water were registered by the water meter, and the bill for that period was \$560.02. Staff first re-read the meter at the property to ensure the meter was not misread and checked for a leak.

The District currently has Ordinance 2007-1 in place that provides that billing adjustments may be approved for high water usage provided that the following conditions are met:

- "The owner must produce evidence of a break or malfunction that was not reasonably detectable", and
- "The owner must produce evidence the break or malfunction has been repaired", and
- "The District determines there is no evidence that the excess use of water was due to the willful act or the negligence of the consumer or the consumer's agent(s)"

All three conditions must be met for the General Manager to approve a water bill credit. The owners requested a leak adjustment, but there was no evidence of a break or malfunction, or that a repair was made. Alternatively, your Board could choose to treat this like an instance of leak relief. If the formula in Ordinance 2007-1 for issuing leak relief credits was applied in this circumstance, the bill would be reduced to \$344.66.

If your Board is inclined to grant a billing adjustment based on the formula established in Ordinance 2007-1, this would result in a billing credit of \$215.36.

Attached to this letter is our water usage from Nov. 2017 to the present, which indicates an average consumption of 9. On our last statement the usage went to 73 (8 times average)! When we received the bill, we called the office and they sent a technicion out to check. The technicion reported that everything was normal as usual. When we got there, we checked faucets, baths, toilets, etc. and nothing was running. Our street is a one-way, deadend and no indication that neighbors or others used the water. We are at a loss as to what could have happened.

We understand that this does not qualify for the "leak relief" rule, but since we were informed that our usuage is back to our "old normal", could you please apply the "leak relief" rule to us?
